Key challenges facing processing in Nigeria

- Volatile raw material environment driven by subsidised uncontrolled competition from foreign markets
- Disorganized raw material market with several layers of middle men who don't add any value just increase cost of raw material
- High cost of financing which creates pricing disadvantage versus foreign processors (not cashew specific)



Key challenges facing processing in Nigeria


 No local support industry – which implies most equipment and machine are imported leading to high cost of maintenance/expansion (including lead time)

Shortage of skilled labour (not cashew specific)





Why the public sector should support processing



It's the strategic thing to do..... Vietnam, a very successful and significant cashew player, provides significant incentives and support for its cashew industry



These initiatives could transform the industry

- Create a procurement window for local processors to buy RCN before exporters
- Introduce export tax on RCN to support the growth of the sector through reinvestment across the value chain
 - Set up a council to manage the funds ensure it's invested to support farmers, processors, capacity building etc



These initiatives could transform the industry

 Facilitate access to single digits funding for local processors

 Introduce tax rebate for companies that process cashew nuts
