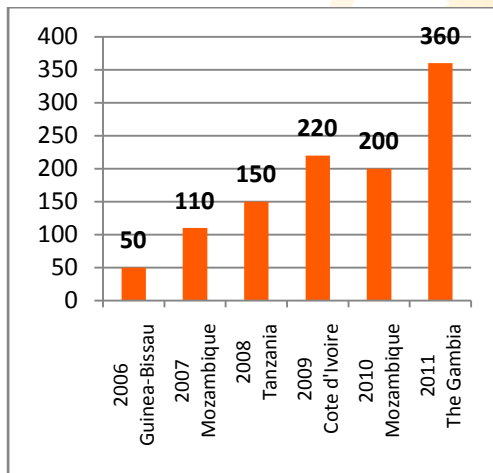


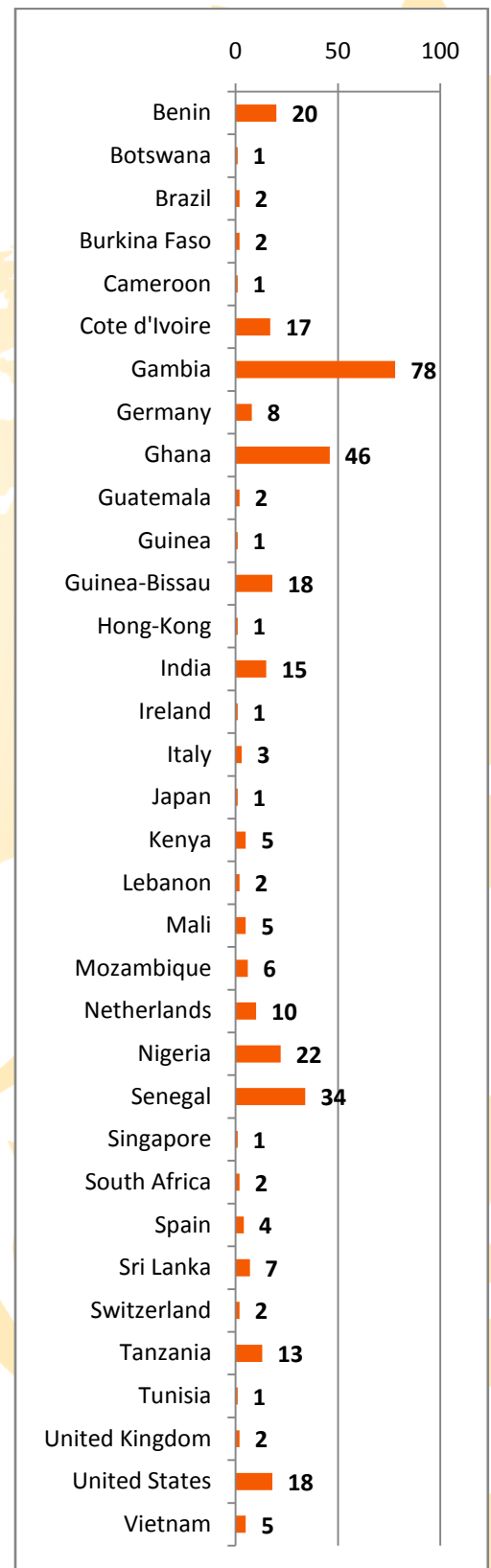


## The 6<sup>th</sup> African Cashew Alliance Annual Conference, September 19 – 22 2011 in The Gambia - A success story

'Bringing the cashew world together' - this was the visionary theme of the ACA conference 2011. With a final count of 360 participants from 34 countries, which equals an increase in attendance of 75% from last year, the ACA exceeded even its own expectations.

Throughout the two day long program a rich choice of topics was presented to this year's audience. On Tuesday, 20 September 2011 cashew business stakeholders ranging from small-holder farmers to leading players from the U.S., Europe, Brazil, India and Vietnam discussed their vision for the cashew sector in a plenary session. On Wednesday, 21 September 2011 the participants were invited to choose between 15 different sessions and actively engage into discussions, workshops and role plays in small groups.

A tightly organized business to business forum simultaneous to these options further provided the opportunity to network with cashew players all along the value chain.

A newcomer to the conference was the 1<sup>st</sup> World Cashew Expo where cashew equipment was displayed and demonstrated next to brochure exhibitions by various cashew stakeholders.

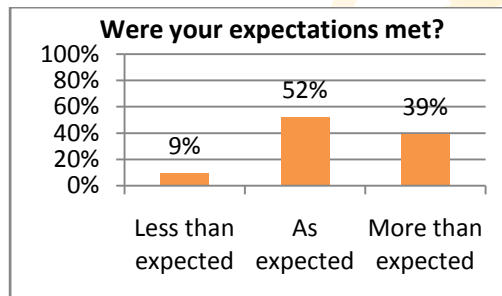

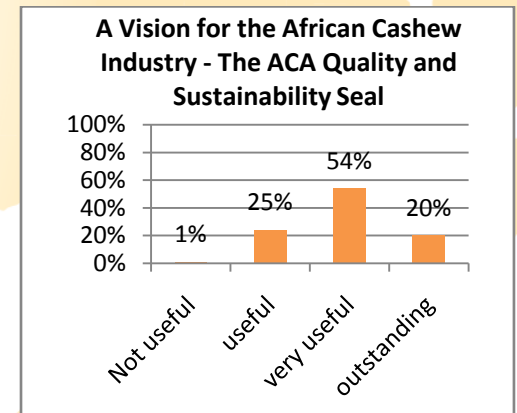


### Day 1: Plenary Session

After a short welcome address and opening, the day started with a 'Vision for the African Cashew Industry – The ACA Quality and Sustainability Seal'. In this session the ACA Seal was introduced as an innovative tool to monitor the sustainability of cashew production processes in a highly competitive market. Along with quality and food safety standards that will foster an increase in productivity of the African cashew business, the Seal will also include a social responsibility component by supervising labor and transparency standards.

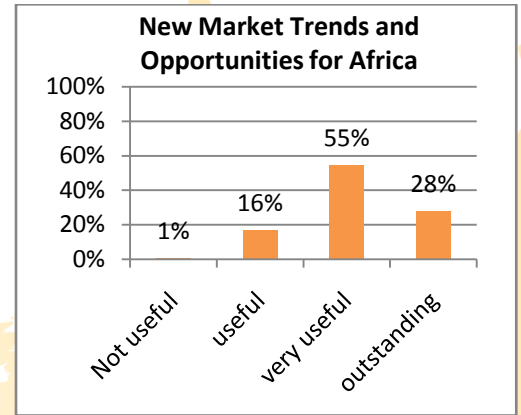
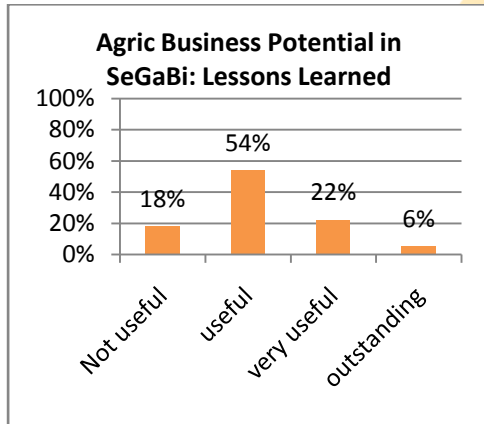


During 'Agric Business Potential in SeGaBI: Lessons Learned' the message was communicated that tax incentives and other conducive policies set by governments are important to help business grow. It was however pointed out that apart from tailor-made policies, political and economic stability of states is crucial for the growth of national cashew industries.



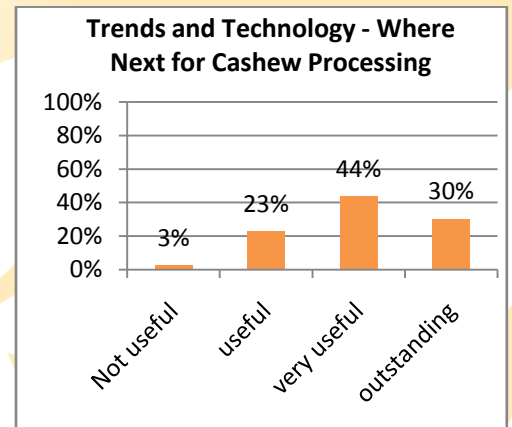
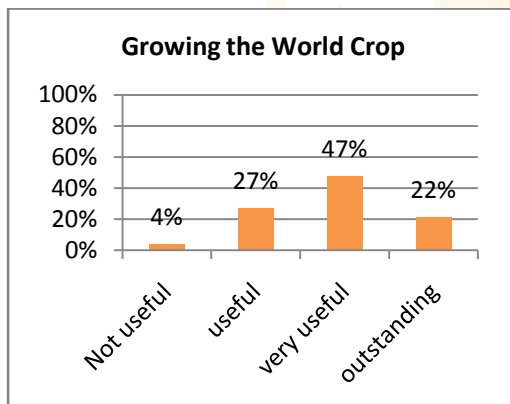

'Growing the World Crop' set a focus on the production level. Insights were offered into the necessity of training farmers in 'Good Agricultural Practices' (GAPs) and proper handling of finances. Beyond that it was emphasized that for cashew business to become truly profitable in Africa, farmers should organize themselves into unions and through this develop a stronger base for negotiations.

In 'Trends and Technology – Where Next for Cashew Processing?' purchasing options for buying processing equipment were presented. Using the 'Cashew Processing Equipment Study' commissioned by the African Cashew initiative, trends in cashew processing were explained. It became clear that African cashew processing is far away from a 'one size fits all' mentality. To determine the best equipment for a processor it is necessary to assess the processor's strengths, weaknesses and needs individually on a case to case basis.



The session 'New Market Trends and Opportunities in Africa' pointed out that there is a quickly growing demand for cashew worldwide - especially in the emerging economies in Asia. Cashew producers and processors in Africa can be beneficiaries of this demand if they succeed in increasing productivity and improving the quality of their produce - while also stimulating their own domestic markets.

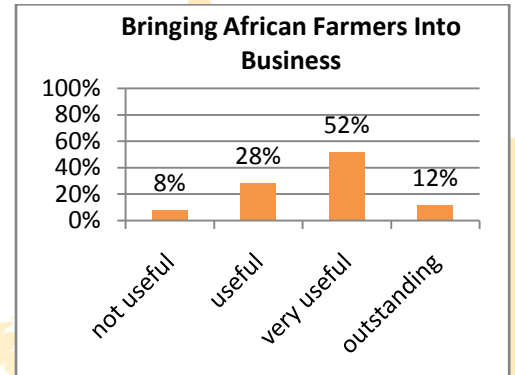
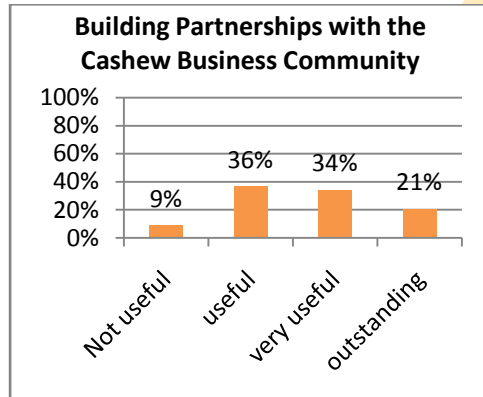

### Day 2: World Cashew Expo Forum

**“The interactive sessions exposed me to people with different visions and ideas about cashew, which has given me a bigger and broader understanding about my own endeavors in cashew.”**

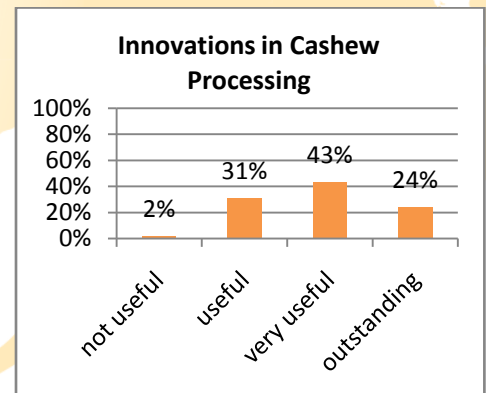
On the second day an open forum was held. The open forum consisted of 5 different forums with a total of 15 sessions that lasted all day. As usual for an open forum the participants had the chance to change forums according to their interest throughout the day. More detailed reports of the discussions produced by these sessions are available on the ACA website.

### Bringing African Cashew Farmers into Business

This forum discussed the difficulties that African farmers have when establishing cashew farming as a profitable business. Problems identified were mainly imperfect farming techniques, weak linkages with processors, insufficient business skills of farmers and poor organization of farmers unions.

### Innovations in Cashew Processing

This session addressed the challenges and opportunities that African processors are facing. While they often struggle with limited access to finance, volatility of labor force, low productivity and high competition for RCN, the prospects for success are promising if those challenges can be overcome. A well-planned investment strategy for processing equipment can offer a distinctive advantage on the highly competitive market.



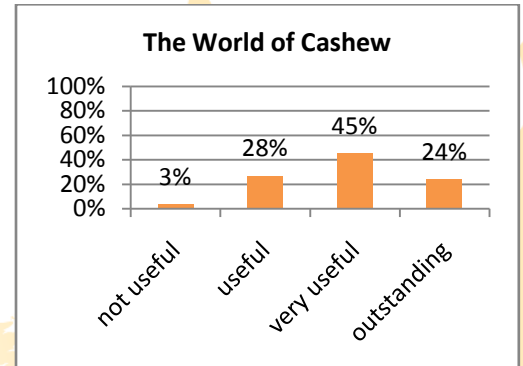
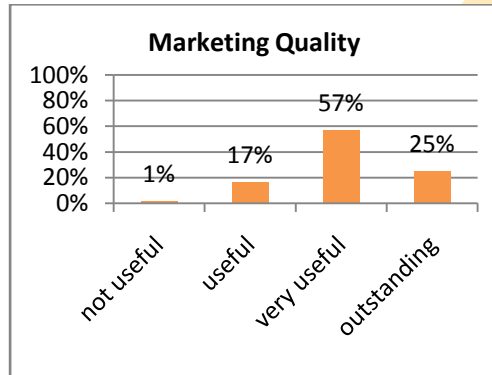
### Marketing Quality

This forum mainly dealt with the launching of the ACA Quality and Sustainability Seal that will monitor compliance with food safety and quality standards in cashew processing. The forum revealed a great interest and demand for the Seal from the industry side. The participants agreed that a timeline for a prompt implementation should be set.

### Finance and Investment

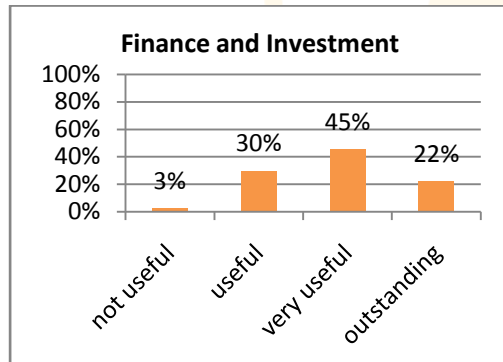

### Networking

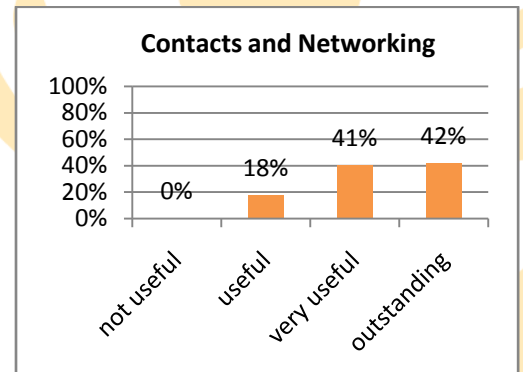
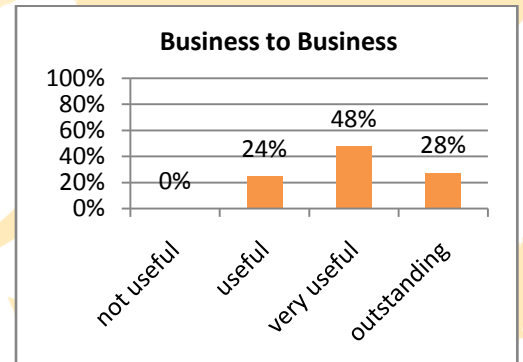

This body will meet annually to discuss possibilities to supervise industry innovations such as quality standards and marketing options.





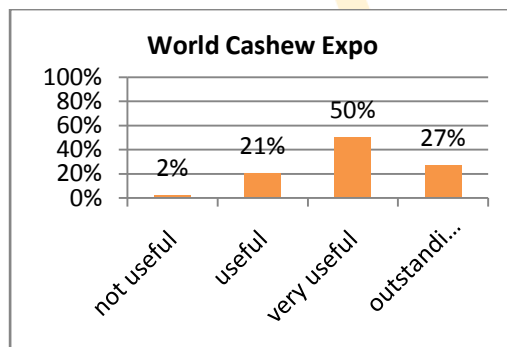

### World Cashew Expo

Running alongside the 6<sup>th</sup> annual conference was the debut of the 1<sup>st</sup> World Cashew Expo. Stakeholders from a diverse array of cashew growing countries exhibited at 15 brochure and informational material stands. Information was provided on topics ranging from tax incentive schemes administered by governmental institutions to country strategies by development initiatives to information on the variety of cashew products that are available on the market. Participants especially enjoyed sampling and buying cashew products with a variety of taste and preparation methods.

A main attraction of the expo and the conference was the exhibition of cashew processing equipment. Buddhi Industries from Sri Lanka and Cao Thanh Phat from Vietnam brought and demonstrated shelling, peeling, grading and packing machines. Both companies succeeded in selling their equipment right on the spot to conference attendees. Inspired by this great success the ACA is looking forward to an even greater event next year in Cotonou.
